Purpose:	As part of the HSE/OE corporate teams, the position provides hands on support for Road Transportation management strategies across Sol countries. This role is a direct support function for the Road Transportation Manager in the implementation of global and regional procurement, maintenance, and data mining/analysis/reporting.
Principal Accountabilities:	Supporting and coordinating the implementation of the management framework and field support as required for all fleet (over 200 Heavy Goods Vehicles and a diverse fleet of Light Goods Vehicles) in the Sol Group as per the following focus areas:
	 Policy Ensures Sol's Road Transportation Goods and Equipment Guidelines policy is implemented across the Sol Group. Road Transport HSE Case – Provides support for the development and maintenance of market road transport cases. Liaison with Parkland Fleet management team to mine data and ensure alignment on general framework for fleet replacement strategy, maintenance guidelines, KPIs etc.
	 Contracting/Procurement Vendor relations – Primary communication for 3rd party vendors, original equipment manufacturers and tank body upfitters on approved asset procurement. CapEx management – data gathering from historical spend, market requirements, global pricing changes etc. to support annual CapEx budget development. Support the market implementation of Sol procurement requirements in alignment with Parkland Global procurement guidelines. Maintain template for third-party transport service provider contracts in support of the markets' contractual agreements. Maintenance Coordination of external technical service inspections in conjunction with the markets. Support the analysis of OPEX spend for fleet across Sol Group for trend analysis and optimization of spend through synergies by collating historical spend data.

Fleet Programs

- Ownership and management of the Sol Group fleet database for acquisitions and disposals in liaison with the markets, Fixed Assets team and Finance.
- Subject matter expertise (SME) support for Geotab/FleetCam (or alternate) in-vehicle monitoring systems to the markets and Road Transport Manager.
- Reporting Data gathering of all market data inputs for KPI assessment of overall fleet maintenance and utilization.

HSE & Training

 Support the coordination of technical trainings for fleet management personnel in markets as developed by the Road Transportation Manager.
